Core Tags

<code><!DOCTYPE html></code>	Declared at the start of every page
<code><html> </html></code>	Main HTML container tags
<code><head> </head></code>	Head of the document isn't rendered but includes important components like meta tags and title
<code><body> </body></code>	Body tags for the main content of the page

Head Tags

<code><meta charset="UTF-8"></code>	Define the character set which is usually UTF-8
<code><title> </title></code>	Title of the page, used as tab title and in search engine results.
<code><meta name="description" content=""></code>	Meta description tag used as search engine description. Max recommended length is 160 characters.
<code><script src=""></script></code>	Include external Javascript file
<code><link href="" rel="stylesheet"></code>	Include external CSS file

Structure Tags

<code><div> </div></code>	Content is usually placed within a div block or box which can be positioned using CSS.
<code> </code>	In-line version of a div. Often used to change content without adjusting the layout.
<code><h1> </h1></code>	Heading tags range from h1 being the biggest to h6 being the smallest.
<code>
</code>	Line break
<code><p> </p></code>	Paragraph tags, normally used to encapsulate text content
<code><hr></code>	Horizontal rule, straight line

Element Tags

<code><button> </button></code>	Displays a button which can trigger a Javascript event
<code><form> </form></code>	Online form can contain inputs such as <code><input type="text" /></code>
<code> </code>	Lists ul = unordered list, ol = numbered list, li = list item
<code> </code>	Link to external resource or internal if # is used to denote an element ID.
<code><table><tr><td></td></tr></table></code>	Table element tr = rows, td = cells, th = heading cells
<code></code>	Image file, an alt="" tag can be added to provide text content for screen readers and SEO purposes.
<code><iframe src=""></iframe></code>	Used to embed 3rd party resources and content such as Youtube videos
<code><!-- --></code>	HTML Comment, not rendered on page, used for developer notes
